Water scarcity is the next big challenge

World Water Day – 22 March 2020

23 March 2020 - There is another crisis looming: that of water scarcity. On 22 March every year the South African government adopts World Water Day as a time to underline the importance of water.

"After a very somber week, government and the private sector need to address the challenges ahead due to water scarcity," says Mannie Jnr. Ramos, COO of [Abeco](#), the world's first 'bank' for water and leader in hygienic water storage solutions in Africa for over 35 years.

"Water scarcity is the next big threat we face in the coming months as the Coronavirus pandemic spreads, particularly in our country where there is a wide gap between 'first' and 'third' worlds.

Not having access to water to frequently wash hands, could mean the difference between life or death for some."

Ramos does not welcome calling attention to this fact while our country is facing concerns around safety and their livelihoods, due to Covid-19.

"This issue has to be voiced," he says, "there is a very real threat to those living in areas where water is not accessible. In addition, the drain on existing water resources which are already in crisis, needs to be addressed in our Coronavirus

crisis planning, sooner rather than later."

According to the 2018 General Household Survey from Statistics South Africa, while there were improvements to the supply of tap water inside dwellings in regions like Western Cape and Gauteng and the Western Cape, less than half of South Africans have access to piped water in their houses. Nearly 50% of others rely on communal sources, such as community or neighbours' taps or rivers.

He believes there are signs that water scarcity is increasing, citing recent news reports about water shortages in the Eastern Cape, a KZN water shutdown, water-shedding in Polokwane, water riots in the Free State, as well as water cuts in Tshwane, Mpumalanga and more.

"A week-long riot happened in QwaQwa in February 2020 due to chronic water shortages in the Free State region," he points out.

Farmers in the Northern Cape are suffering as their rain-fed agricultural livelihood is threatened.

"We can't keep blaming weather uncertainty, drought or climate change for the water situation we are facing as a country, we must all take responsibility," Ramos firmly believes.

"Rainfall in SA has always been unpredictable and variable," comments Ramos, "we must build infrastructure with enough capacity to cope with regular dry periods. We are not implementing the right water strategies to increase supply and curb demand, which is very concerning to me."

Which brings us to the current crisis facing the entire nation. Ramos says the

private and public sector need to work together to address this risk and come up with solutions that will assist with water conservation and water access.

"We have to stand together; water scarcity and Coronavirus strategies need to be developed in conjunction with each other right now."

Data shows that South Africans consume about 237 litres of water per person per day, if this increased even by a marginal percentage, the impact on water resources has to be planned for.

South Africans' water usage per person is already well above the world average of 173 litres per day.

"We need to get smarter with our water resources," emphasises Ramos. "New solutions need to be put in place or the gap between demand for water, and the supply thereof, will continue to widen."

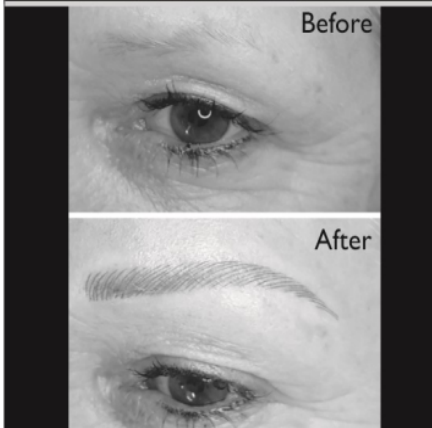

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU SUSPECT A CHILD IS BEING ABUSED

If you suspect a child is being abused what to do and where to go to

Go to the police immediately and tell them what you suspect or what happened. They will take down basic information ie. Name of child and when it happened

What happens next?

The police will phone a trained VEP (Victim Empowerment) member and the child will be taken to the VEP room where he/she will be supported by a trained VEP volunteer

A social worker and the FCS Unit (Family violence, Child protection and Sexual offences Unit) will be contacted by the police and supplied with a docket number. The FCS unit will take a statement in

presence of the Social worker.

Should it be necessary, the child will be taken to hospital by a FCS member or the police, accompanied by the VEP member and the parent.

Should the child be taken to hospital, a medical examination will be done by a doctor. If necessary, the child will be hospitalised. The child may be discharged and taken home. The forensic team will go the scene of the crime, take photos and collect the necessary evidence.

The police will keep in contact with the parents on any development.

Should the accused be arrested a court date for first appearance will be established. Should the parent and child need support the Green Hearts will be there for them.

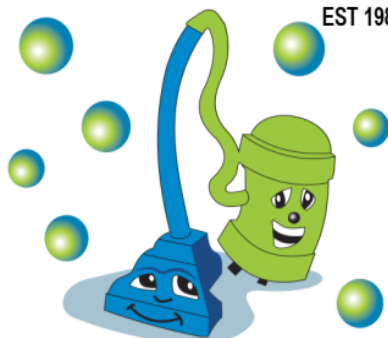

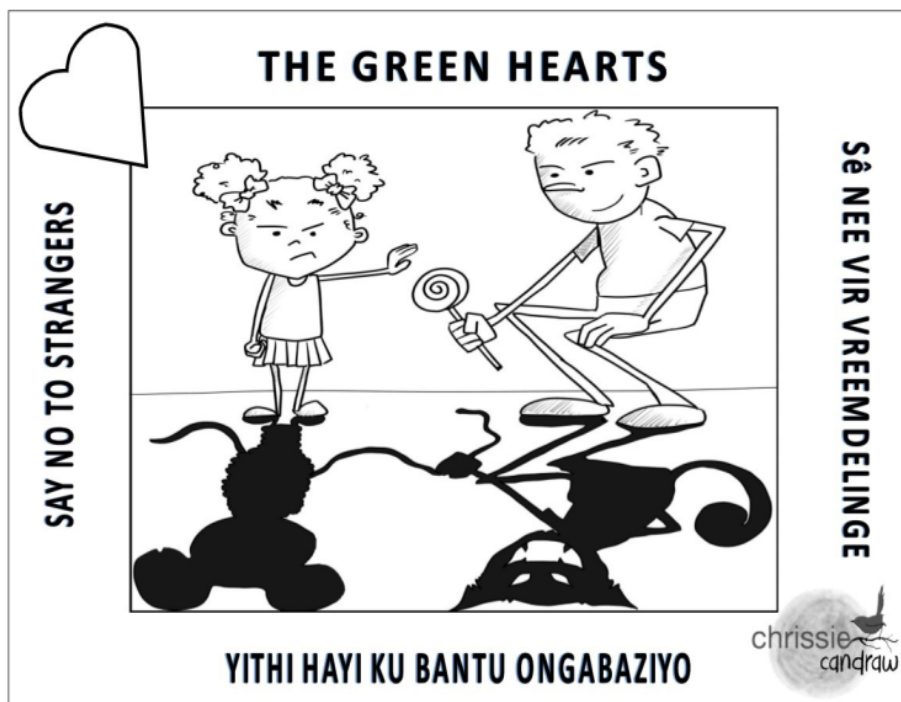

2. Determination: When you can feel that you're less positive about self-isolation, but you're determined to keep going and stick to your routine and have a schedule to help you manage the situation.
3. Satisfaction and frustration: You'll experience times when you're more productive, and times that you're less productive, and alternate between moments of satisfaction and periods of frustration.
4. Depression: When you start struggling and feeling, "this is hard". Boredom might settle in. Your routine or lack of routine might not be working for you anymore. You might experience restlessness that makes it difficult to concentrate. You miss going out and seeing friends and loved ones. You might feel demotivated, hopeless, or feel a sense of despair.
5. Anger: You might experience anger about the situation, the confinement, and get easily irritated by others in your household.
6. Acceptance: When you accept the situation for what it is and carry on doing whatever is in your control and letting go of what is not in your control.
7. Making meaning: Remembering that this move to self-isolate is necessary and that you're serving humanity and the greater good to help prevent more sickness and death."

KWANO LAUNCHES A MUCH-NEEDED CRIME PREVENTION UNIT

The community of Kwanokuthula (Kwano), a formalized area in Plettenberg Bay and within the Bitou Municipality, launched a much-needed community inspired crime prevention unit on the 5th of May at Kwanokuthula Community Hall. The unit was established on the 14th of February 2020.



The unit includes representation from taxi operators, local business people, members of the clergy and concerned residents generally, all sharing a common vision of abolishing crime in Kwano.

The unit comes after Kwano has seen a rise in what Kwano Crime Prevention has identified as the challenges facing their area right now, including housebreaking, drugs, poor street lights, staggering rape cases and lack of police officers.

They have partnered with a number of community based organizations who were also in attendance at the launch, they include among others Green Hearts, Youth Community Changers, New Horizon Neighbourhood Watch, Bitou Law Enforcement and Community Policing Forums.

One upset was the absence of the South African Police Service.

The main speaker for the night was regional head of the Correctional Services Department, Mrs Boo, who spoke on the importance of collaboration among key stakeholders in fighting crime in our communities.

The organiser of the Kwano Crime Prevention unit, Mr Sindile Mdlalani, told us that without the support of local businesses in Kwano, the launch would have never happened, he also expressed their gratitude to the local Clicks shop at

Melville's corner for their contribution.

As a tourism town, crime is one of our biggest challenges we need to nip so that Plett remains a preferred tourist destination for our visitors. It is the responsibility of all of us to belong to a neighbourhood watch, police forum or unit in our respective areas, in order to make sure that we all play a role in keeping Plett safe.

silver-Proverbs 25v11

Let's just remind ourselves that the Beatitudes that Jesus taught on the mountainside in Matthew chapter 5 are a living illustration of what the day to day life of His followers should look like. This is particularly relevant now as we face the very real challenges brought on by the Corona virus. Today we consider verse 5 the 3rd Beatitude- **Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.** The second half of the verse concerns itself with the new heaven and earth that God will prepare for the redeemed.

In a way the idea of meekness does not resonate with the natural man who is successful, forward thinking, goal orientated and driven. For some it has an undertone of weakness, but Jesus would never advocate a life of weakness. There is something more special here and we see it clearly when we consider the Afrikaans word for Meekness / Sagmoedigheid. A direct translation speaks of a 'soft [sag] courage' [moed]. Soft courage is what Jesus was best known for and is exactly what he expects of His followers.

Furthermore, Dr Martyn Lloyd Jones gives an important insight when he points out that meekness is a matter of grace and not genetics. It is not the same as natural niceness. Nobody is meek by nature, and that is why the Bible speaks of meekness or gentleness as a fruit of the Spirit.

[Galatians 5] It is only by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit that a person can be genuinely meek. It flows and grows from a heart that has been changed by God. So then, what does this meekness look like in daily life

1. Meekness concerns itself with the Glory of God. It does not ask for special privileges or resort to self-pity.

2. Meekness is not provoked by Criticism. It does not allow personal offence to drive the response but resorts to a display of soft courage.

3. Meekness deals gently with those who oppose the faith: *And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must*

be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth.-2 Timothy 2v24
4. Meekness deals gently with the failures of others.

5. Meekness allows for a teachable spirit. *Ps 25:9 The meek He will guide in what is right and teach them His way.*

2020 Knysna Motor Show scheduled for May 3 is

cancelled due to COVID-19

Due to the COVID-19 lockdown, the 2020 Knysna Motor Show, scheduled for May 3, has been cancelled. The organisers confirm that there will be no Knysna Motor Show this year, due to the lockdown imposed by the government on March 15.

Chief organiser Peter Pretorius, on behalf of the organising club, the Garden Route Motor Club, has issued the following statement:

"It is with much regret and sadness that we herewith advise that the Knysna motor show (KMS) **planned for May 3 has been cancelled**. The influencing factors in arriving at this decision are the banning of gatherings of more than 100 people, as outlined by the President, and the withdrawal of sponsors from the event."

"Through consultations, uncertainty about the future, the health risk for elderly people and the restrictions imposed in the president's emergency announcement last night, we have also decided that unfortunately **no Knysna motor show will take place at a later stage in 2020 either**. In the greater scheme of things the Knysna motor show is sacrificial, and from today we are entering a period of unprecedented uncertainty in this modern world that we live in."

A thought for the Week

Matthew 11:30 [MKJV]

"For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

I'm not afraid to admit that, even as a Christian, I sometimes carry a burden that presses heavily on me as I struggle to deal with the cares of this life and the heartaches we often experience.

In these troubled days of testing with the threat of Covid-19 infection looming over virtually every person on the planet, this is a feeling that probably many or even most of us have to deal with and experience from time to time.

However, in spite of this, isn't it wonderful to know that in the midst of such periods of utter confusion and uncertainty we know, with absolute certainty, that God is still on the throne and in control of everything and that He is always there for us.

David, the Psalm writer, knew all about troubles, probably more than anyone of us and experienced many of them not only as the king of Israel, but also as a family man, and he writes: **"Give your worries to the LORD, and He will care for you. He will never let those who are good be defeated."** [Psa. 55:22 ERV]

At another time - in the midst of serious



affliction - he writes these comforting words: **"Praise the Lord! Every day He helps us with the loads we must carry; He is the God who saves us."**

[Psa. 68:19 ERV]

We must, however, understand that these promises are reserved only for those who have realized their total need of God and know that, in their own strength, they won't be able to deal with all the adversities that life constantly throws at us.

Only when one has come to a place of complete surrender to Christ, can one call upon Him as one's "Shepherd" and appropriate the well-known promises contained in David's 23rd Psalm: **"The Lord is my shepherd - I shall not want..."**

In writing this week's Thought I was reminded of an old familiar Gospel song **"He touched me"**, recorded by Bill and Gloria Gaither in 1964; the first lines read as follows:

"Shackled by a heavy burden - neath a load of guilt and shame; then the hand of Jesus touched me and now I am no longer the same. He touched me, oh, He touched me and oh the joy that floods my soul; something happened and now I know: He

touched me and made me whole!"

Right now, as we are facing a very uncertain future let us bring our burdens to the Lord and ask Him to carry them for us, keeping in mind all the time that no matter what lies ahead, we as believers in Christ are in a "Win-Win" situation knowing that if we shall live we are with Him [I'll never leave you, nor forsake you!] but should we die we will also be with Him. 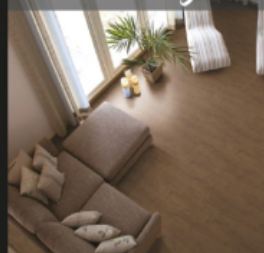

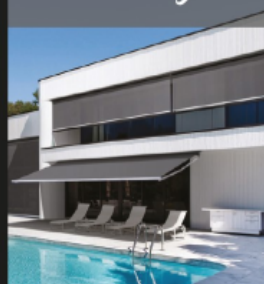
